Ingredients

- 3 oz white chocolate, melted
- 2 tsp green food coloring gel
- 12 (.85 oz) Halloween Fun Size Twix®
- 12 pretzel sticks, halved
- 3 tbsp chocolate cookie crumbs
- 1 oz dark chocolate, melted
- 24 small candy eyes

Instructions

1. 1

In small bowl, stir together melted white chocolate and green food coloring. Dip each TWIX® into bowl, shaking excess chocolate back into bowl.

2. 2

Transfer to parchment paper-lined tray. Place pretzel stick halves on each side of Twix in lower third of bar to resemble Frankenstein's bolts. Sprinkle tops of each TWIX® with cookie crumbs to resemble hair. Let stand for at least 1 hour or until chocolate is set.

3. 3

Scrape melted dark chocolate into piping bag fitted with small round tip. Pipe 2 dots onto each TWIX®; press candy eyes onto dots. Drizzle melted chocolate in crooked line for mouth.

4. Tip

For quick and easy decorating, substitute a tube of store-bought brown or black food coloring gel for melted dark chocolate.
